Introduction - Marcey Shafer

- Marcey reviewed the list of 2021 levy promises and provided updates on the park district's progress towards achieving each goal.

Partnership Focus - Marcey Shafer and David Hague, Guest

- Marcey introduced David Hague, owner of Coyote Run State Nature Preserve. David gave an overview of Coyote Run's mission and history of land acquisition. A discussion about a continued partnership with Coyote Run and utilizing the site for future programs followed.

Divestments - Marcey Shafer

- Marcey reviewed a list of properties formerly owned or leased by FCPD that did not align with the goals and mission of the park district and have been divested to other public agencies. A list of properties currently owned by FCPD to be considered for future divestment was also discussed.

Zeller Park – Tommy Springer

- Tommy provided information about Zeller Park and potential concerns over the lease agreement with PYSA/PASA. A discussion about future development and improvements of underutilized portions of the park followed.

Lunch - Shelter House

Park Improvements – Tommy Springer (Smeck and Wagner)

Marcey Shafer (Mambourg, Rock Mill, Two Glaciers)

- Tommy discussed 2024 improvements to Smeck Park, including: opening of Goldenrod Trail and
 installing electric in the Fetter-Hood barn; and Wagner Preserve, including: partnerships with USFWS to
 utilize ODNR H2Ohio funds to break field tile and restore natural hydrology and Liberty Union School
 District to install a remote feed camera to monitor a Blue Heron nest.
- Marcey discussed 2024 improvements to Mambourg Park, including the creation of a natural play area, a trail extension, and invasive species removal. Planning for nature center exhibits is nearly done with a ribbon cutting expected in spring of 2026; Stebelton Park at Rock Mill, including: repairs to the forebay and exterior access walkway and regrading the gorge access; and Two Glaciers Park, including: completion of permitting and survey work for the H2Ohio wetland project.

Programs and Events - Miranda Cain

- Miranda provided attendance data for various 2024 programs and events. She explained the program
 categories were refined from previous years and that accounted for the figures looking different than in
 years past.
- She also discussed future program planning and introduced an outline for creating a Strategic Education Plan.

Finance and Budgeting - Chad Reed

 Chad went over financial and budgetary data for 2024 and provided a list of projected major expenditures in 2025.

Staff Accomplishments – Marcey Shafer

 Marcey provided a brief list of trainings, goal achievements, and other staff accolades accomplished in 2024.
